Edmund Rice College is offering Academic Scholarships to students enrolling at the College in Year 7, 2022. The full Academic Scholarship covers Tuition and Activity Fees and Compulsory Family Levy and is offered for six years but renewed annually on the basis of conscientious application to academic study and all facets of College life.

The College must receive the Academic Scholarship application by **Thursday, 1 April 2021** to be eligible for consideration. Please note the Academic Scholarship test morning is on **Saturday, 8 May 2021** commencing at 9.00am in the Edmund Rice Centre. The test morning is expected to conclude at 11.30am.

The process of application for an Academic Scholarship will involve the sitting of a placement test followed by an interview for shortlisted candidates.

SCHOLARSHIP POLICY 2021

1. The College offers up to five Academic Scholarships to students in Year 7 each year.
2. Academic Scholarships are awarded on the basis of performance in the Enrichment Test administered by the College, followed by an interview.

(The interview will be for shortlisted candidates after reviewing the test results)
3. The Scholarship is offered for six years, covering the four years of junior school (Years 7-10), and the two years of senior school (Years 11-12), pending satisfactory academic results over that time.
4. The Scholarship is reviewed annually. The minimum expected standard achieved must be an "A" in the majority of the core subjects (English, Mathematics, Science, Religion, History and Geography). These results would be a combination of all Semester One and Semester Two results. The Scholarship will continue for one year following a failure to meet the required average. Following the year of grace, a failure to achieve the minimum expected standard over the course of the year will result in the Scholarship being reviewed.
5. The Scholarship covers all Tuition and Activities Fees and the Compulsory Family Levy. The only fee payable is the \$200.00 Application Fee which is non-refundable.
6. Scholarships are open to students seeking a position at the College from the beginning of Year 7.
7. To qualify, prospective students must:
 - i) Register by filling in the *Application Form for a Scholarship* (the Application Form is available from the College or can be downloaded from the College website).
 - ii) Lodge the Scholarship application by **Thursday 1 April, 2021**.
 - iii) Attend the Enrichment Test morning at the College on **Saturday 8 May, 2021** from 9.00am – 11.30am.
